



## **GUIDELINE FOR FELLOW NOMINATION**

### **1.0 Criterion for Appointment as Fellow**

The Constitution of Institut Fizik Malaysia provides the following criteria in Article 5. II. (B) for the appointment of a Fellow of IFM:

*"Every candidate for election or transfer to the class of Fellow of the Institute shall have attained the age of thirty years and either:*

*(a) shall be members of the Institute or shall have received a general education and have been educated as physicist, in a manner satisfactory to the Council and obtained an honours degree or its equivalent recognized by the Council for the purposes of this Clause and in addition either:*

*(i) have had experience for not less than seven years of responsible work in physics or its applications which shall satisfy the Council;*

*or*

*(ii) have had experience for not less than ten years in responsible work which demands a knowledge of physics which shall satisfy the Council for the purposes of this Clause;*

*or*

*(b) although not possessing an academic qualification recognized by the Council for the purposes of Clause (a) shall have made such outstanding contributions either to physics or to the profession of physics, through means demanding a sufficient knowledge of physics, as shall make it desirable, in the opinion of the Council, that the candidate shall be a fellow of the Institute."*

### **2.0 Proposing of Candidates for Appointment as Fellow**

- 2.1 Nomination must be based on scientific or industrial merit and NOT based on current position.
- 2.2 It is the responsibility of the Proposer to ensure that:
  - (a) The nomination form is complete and that it includes the signature of the seconding Fellow
  - (b) The nomination form should be supported also by detailed curriculum vitae.
  - (c) The nomination form to be submitted before or on the **30<sup>th</sup> April each year.**
- 2.3 A Fellow can only propose maximum TWO nominations as proposer and maximum TWO nominations as seconder within the same year
- 2.4 The proposer and the seconder must know the candidate well enough to be in a position to nominate the candidate. Each Fellow who signs a nomination form



will be deemed thereby to certify that to the best of his/her knowledge and belief the person named therein is qualified to be appointed as Fellow of IFM.

2.5 The nominated member is an active member without any dues in annual fees.

### **3.0 Completing the Nomination Form**

3.1 Nomination form must be typed.

3.2 A complete nomination must consist of the following items:

- Completed nomination form
- Passport photograph taken within the last six months
- Updated Curriculum Vitae

3.3 Any incomplete nomination will be REJECTED and not be considered for nomination.
